



Empowering Educators to Teach Cyber

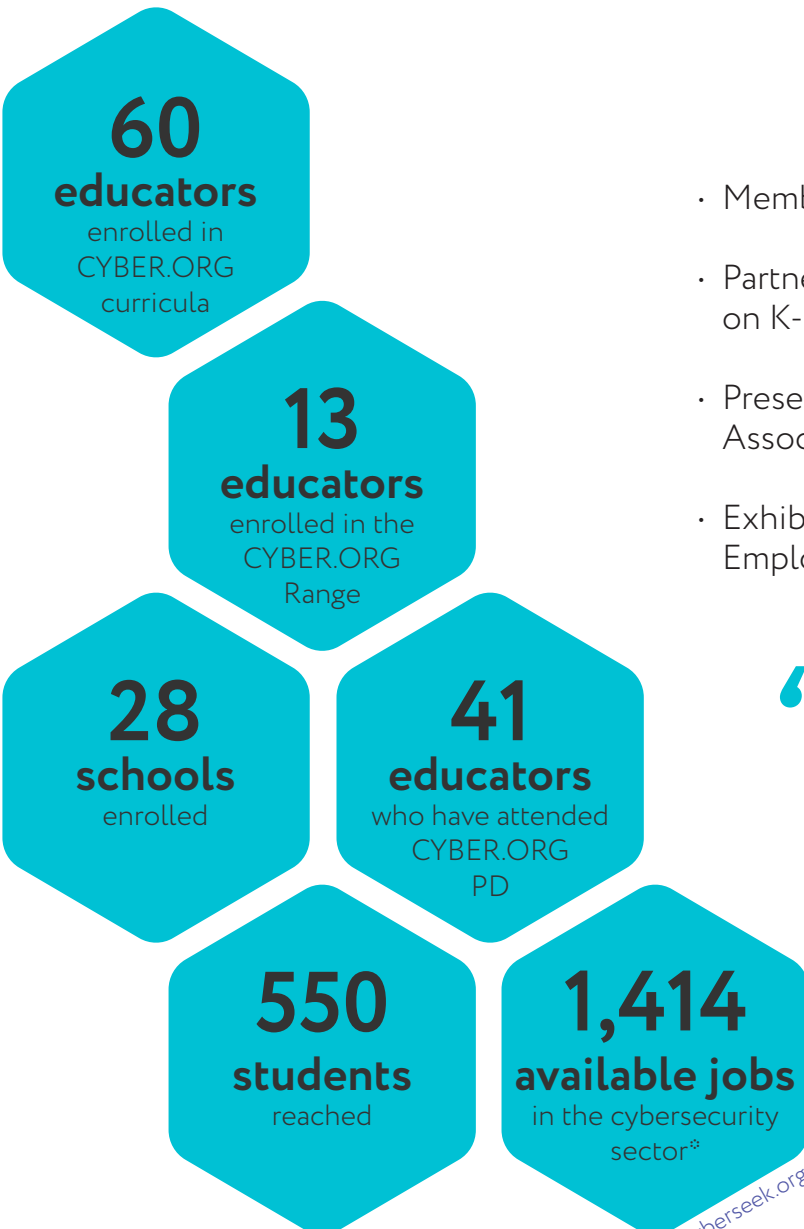
The goal of CYBER.ORG is to empower educators as they prepare the next generation to succeed in the cyber workforce of tomorrow.
