



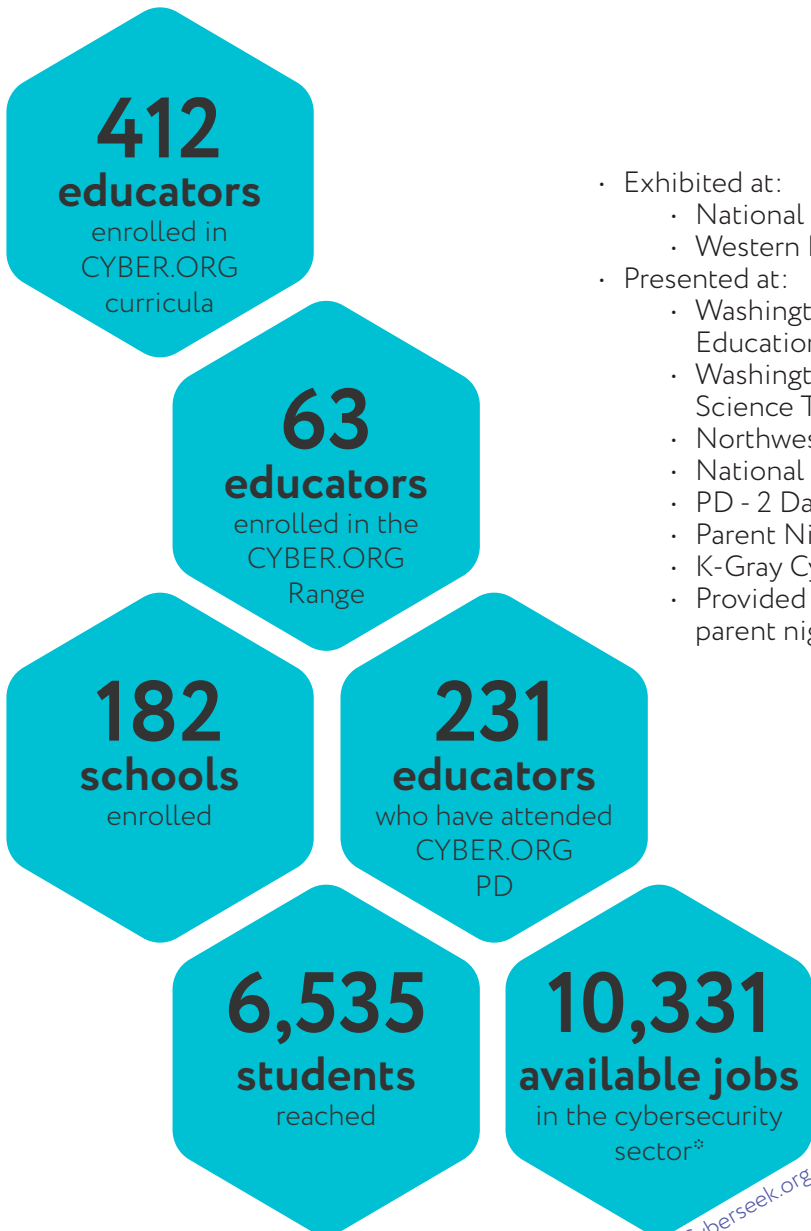
# Empowering Educators to Teach Cyber
